

Healing Principles II

1) Numbers 23:19a NKJV “God *is* not a man, that He should lie,

- a. Can God do anything He wants?
- b. Can God lie?
- c. Can we trust God’s word to be true?

2) Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

a. Does the Bible speak to a reality greater than this physical world? Why is this important?

3) John 14:1 – 3,12 “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father’s house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also. ¹² “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

a. Why does believing in Jesus keep our heart from being troubled rather than just believing in God?

b. Why is it important to know that Jesus has prepared an eternal place for us?

c. Are we supposed to do the works that Jesus did?

4) Mark 1:30 – 31 Simon’s wife’s mother lay sick with a fever, and they told Him about her at once. ³¹ So He came and took her by the hand and lifted her up, and immediately the fever left her. And she served them.

Luke 4:39 ³⁹ So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them.

5) Mark 16:18 – 20 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.” ¹⁹ So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. ²⁰ And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with *them* and confirming the word through the accompanying signs.
